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



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Ally Helman, a Southern California native, cultivated a passion for dance from an early age. After receiving pre-professional training, she attended The School of American Ballet in New York City, where she later went on to perform with the New York City Ballet. In 2019, Helman founded Ballet Project OC, as well as the streaming platform Ballet Project TV, through her unwavering dedication. Since its inception, Ally has been instrumental in taking on artistic leadership, choreography, and dance roles. She has commissioned over forty original pieces for Ballet Project OC, and continues to guide the company towards a bright and prosperous future. In 2023, "The School of Ballet OC" was launched as the official school of Ballet Project OC.

THE CHALLENGE



A Quest to Keep the Art Form Thriving

Ballet is facing a decline across

America, and there are several reasons
for it. The lack of community support
results in fewer job opportunities
offered by professional ballet
companies. Additionally, the industry
has been impacted by unfair practices,
bias, and subjective factors that favor
wealthy or politically influenced
dancers while others are pushed out of
the field.

Identifying the Issue of Unprofessional Standards

The absence of a professional ballet company in Orange County has resulted in the decline of ballet standards due to a inconsistent dependence on outof-state dance groups. This has caused a drop in the quality of ballet in the area, emphasizing the significance of a local, professional company to serve its own community.

Recognizing Up-and-Coming Talent That Goes Elsewhere

In our area, the absence of a professional standard has resulted in young, gifted individuals seeking better opportunities elsewhere. This was the experience of Founder Ally Helman. And it highlights the importance of exposing students to professional environments and providing opportunities for interaction with established artists, as it allows them to unlock their full potential here in OC.
